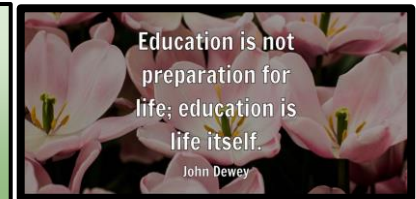

### Huntly West School PRIDE Values

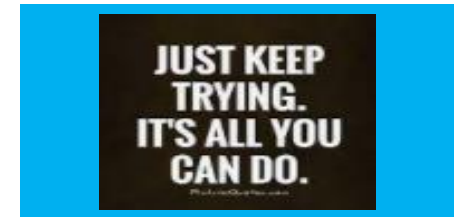
We are responsible for ensuring our tamariki are at the forefront of our decision making. Huntly West staff are dedicated to:
