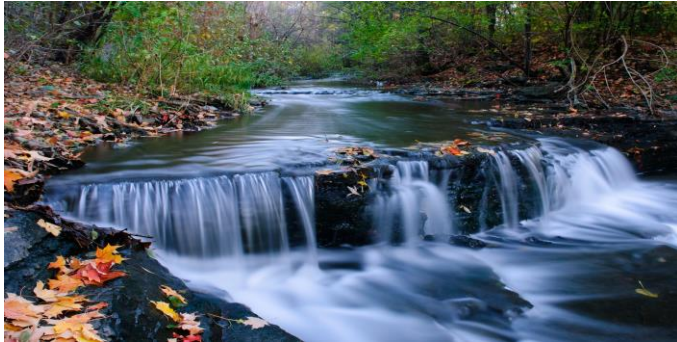




# Huntly West School

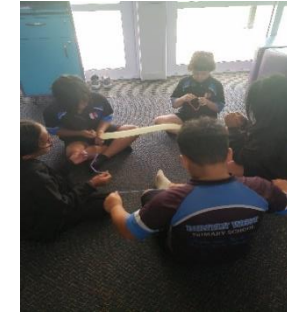
